

KING CHALLENGE

DEED OF GIFT

This trophy is presented to and shall remain in the care of Toledo Ice Yacht Club in perpetuity. It shall forever proudly bear the King name in remembrance of the originators of the Toledo Ice Yacht Club, the King Ice Yacht Club.

The purpose of this challenge, in addition to the memorial, is to promote friendly competition and communications between the Toledo, Sandusky and Monroe Ice Yacht Clubs. The King Challenge shall be issued annually or as often as practical to skippers of DN60 ice yachts who are bonnafide members of the afore mentioned three clubs.

The King Challenge shall consist of not more than five, nor less than three races in DN60 ice yachts. After the first challenge it shall be sailed on the home ice of the club winning the previous challenge. If at the end of January the previous winner has not been able to host the challenge series the Toledo Ice Yacht Club shall have the option to administer the series at a site of their choosing.

While it is the intent of The King Challenge to promote competition between clubs the series of races are in no way to be construed as "Team Races". If, in the opinion of a committee consisting of one representative from each club, any yacht practices "Team Racing" tactics, that yacht shall be disqualified from the race in which this occurred.

All DN60 skippers from each club shall be eligible to compete and there shall be no attempt to level the number of competitors from each club. A low point scoring system shall be used and the series shall be sailed in accordance with the Racing Rules of the National Iceboat Authority. At the end of the series the points awarded to all registered yachts shall be totaled by club, divided by the number of boats registered per club and the club with the lowest average points per boat shall be deemed the winner of the King Challenge and the perpetual trophy shall be so engraved.

In addition to the perpetual trophy, which shall remain in the care of the Toledo Ice Yacht Club, a permanent trophy shall be awarded to the winning club and shall be engraved as follows;

Permanent trophies shall also be awarded to the first three place yachts regardless of club.
